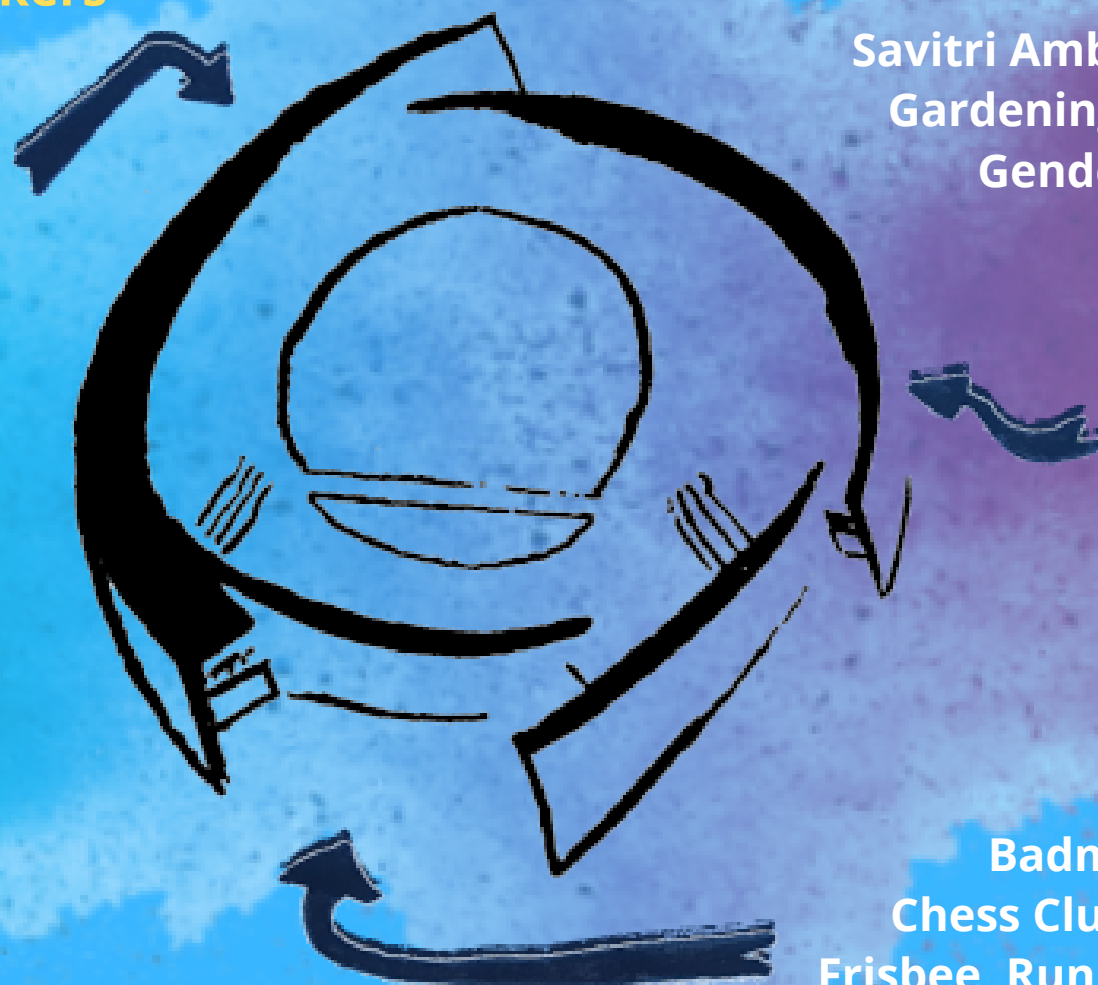
Tag Karaoke | SH 1 @ 8pm-9:30pm
